Napomena: U engleskom jeziku se *ne koristi tačka* pri pisanju rednih brojeva.

1. NUMBERS IN ENGLISH (0 – zero)

◆ Zero:

For the number: Is zero an even or odd number?

For the temperature: -10° C (ten degrees below zero); sub-zero temperatures

◆ Oh (pronounced like the letter "O"):

After the decimal point: 7.01 (seven point oh one)

In telephone numbers: 07156 307 0228 (oh seven one five six / three oh seven / oh double two eight)

In years: 1907 (nineteen oh seven)

◆ Nought:

Sometimes before the decimal point: 0.75 (nought point seven five)

1. NUMBERS IN ENGLISH (0 – zero)

◇ Love:

In tennis: 15-0 (fifteen – love)

◇ Nil:

In British sport scores: 4-0 (four – nil)

◇ Nothing:

In American sport scores: 3-0 (three – nothing / three to nothing).

2. LARGE NUMBERS

Prilikom pisanja, hiljade se odvajaju zarezom.

Napomena: U *britanskom engleskom* koristi se *and* posle reči “hundred”.

873 – eight hundred (and) seventy-three

786,450 – seven hundred (and) eighty-six thousand four hundred (and) fifty

27,805,234 – twenty-seven million eight hundred (and) five thousand two hundred (and) thirty-four

Kada ispred sebe imaju broj/cifru ili kvantifikator, stotine, hiljade, milioni itd. nikada nisu u množini:

There are more than eight ~~billions~~ billion people in the world today. [Danas u svetu ima preko osam milijardi ljudi.]

Množina je moguća jedino kada ispred ovih reči nema broja, odnosno cifre:

There are hundreds of millions active athletes in the world today. [Danas u svetu ima (na) stotine miliona aktivnih sportista.]

2. LARGE NUMBERS

Broj	Kratka skala (engleski)	Duga skala (srpski)
10^6	million	milion
10^9	billion	milijarda
10^{12}	trillion	bilion
10^{15}	quadrillion	bilijarda
10^{18}	quintillion	trilion

3. EXPONENTS (POWERS) AND DECIMALS (Stepeni i decimale)

◇ x^2 – **x squared**

◇ x^3 – **x cubed**

◇ x^{10} – **x raised to the power of ten / x to the power of ten / x to the ten**

Decimale se u engleskom jeziku odvajaju tačkom, za razliku od srpskog, gde se koristi zarez. Tačka se u tom slučaju čita **point**. Svaka cifra posle tačke čita se zasebno:

0.5 (.5)	zero / oh / nought point five (takođe, bez nule: point five)
2.573	two point five seven three

4. FRACTIONS AND PERCENTAGES

(Razlomci i procenti)

Kod razlomaka, **brojilac** se čita kao **osnovni broj** a **imenilac** kao **redni broj**, osim u slučaju *polovine (half)* i *četvrtine (quarter)*. Kada se pišu slovima, obično se imenilac i brojilac razdvajaju crticom.

- ◇ $1/2$ – one-half
- ◇ $1/3$ – one-third
- ◇ $1/4$ – one-quarter
- ◇ $2/3$ – two-thirds
- ◇ $4/5$ – four-fifths
- ◇ $4 \frac{7}{8}$ – four and seven-eighths
- ◇ $23 \frac{1}{2}$ – twenty-three and one-half (a half)

4. FRACTIONS AND PERCENTAGES (Razlomci i procenti)

Procenti se pišu *percent* (ili *per cent*), pri čemu je ova reč uvek u jednini:

- ◆ 1% – one percent
- ◆ 70% – seventy percent
- ◆ 99% – ninety-nine percent
- ◆ 33.33% – thirty-three point three three percent

5. YEARS

Četvorocifrene godine pre 2000. ([two thousand](#)) treba razdvojiti na dva para dvocifrenih brojeva:

- ◇ 1965 = [nineteen sixty-five](#)
- ◇ 1999 = [nineteen ninety-nine](#)
- ◇ 1853 = [eighteen fifty-three](#)

Godine s dvema nulama na kraju ili nulom na trećoj poziciji:

- ◇ 1600 = [sixteen hundred](#)
- ◇ 1900 = [nineteen hundred](#)
- ◇ 1806 = [eighteen oh six](#)
- ◇ 1908 = [nineteen oh eight](#)

5. YEARS

Trocifrene godine:

- ◇ 763 = seven sixty-three *ili* seven hundred (and) sixty-three
- ◇ 231 = two thirty-one *ili* two hundred (and) thirty-one
- ◇ 504 = five oh four

Godine od 2001. do 2009:

- ◇ 2001 = two thousand and one
- ◇ 2009 = two thousand and nine

Od 2010. nadalje:

- ◇ 2012 = two thousand (and) twelve *ili* twenty twelve
